**ORDER**

**AND NOW**, this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2022, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Paragraph 1 of this Court's Order of June 1, 2022 (ECF No. 11) is amended as follows:

1. Per agreement of the parties, Defendants Lehigh County Board of Elections and Northampton County Board of Elections are SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED not to finally certify the returns in the 2022 Democratic Primary for State Senate District 14 and any other races for which the issues raised in this litigation may be outcome-determinative during the pendency of this litigation.

The remainder of the Order remains in full force and effect.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Counsel for Acting Secretary of State Leigh M. Chapman requested this amendment in a letter dated June 3, 2022. (ECF No. 14.) Counsel conferred with all parties, and there are no objections to the request. (*Id.*). The Court issued its original June 1, 2022 Order based on the parties' representations during the telephonic conferences held on May 31 and June 1. The additional language now proposed by the parties was not specifically addressed during those conferences. But, because all parties now join in the instant request without objection, the Court will amend its June 1, 2022 Order.
